My major concern is to ensure that the whole world will learn the lessons of Fukushima and start moving toward the denuclearization, both civilian and military.

I am warning that the fate of the world will be decided by electric companies.

I am convinced that it is the historic role of Japan to contribute to this denuclearization.

A few days ago, Former Prime Minister Junichiro Koizumi publicly expressed his conviction that Japan should decommission as early as possible all nuclear reactors, after visiting Onkaro, nuclear waste disposal site in Finland.

He was deeply impressed by the lack of responsibility to have 54 nuclear reactors without knowing how to dispose the radioactive waste emanating from them. It is accelerating the arrival of a new era in Japan. The impact will be far reaching.

Five of Former Japanese Prime Ministers are now opposed to the present nuclear policy of Japan. Mr. Morihiro Hosokawa, in his interview article published in the Mainichi of 19 September, severely criticized the restart and the export of nuclear reactors, the invitation for the Olympic Games etc. He used the term "criminal" to deplore the present immoral situation.

Mr. Yukio Hatoyama expressed his support for me when I met him on 26 September at the reception held by the Chinese Embassy. Mr. Naoto Kan, as Prime Minister when the disaster occurred, is actively pleading the independence from nuclear generation worldwide. Mr. Yoshihiko Noda in the preceding Government, decided to achieve it in the course of twenty threes.

All this, together with the worsening situation at Fukushima Daiichi, will undoubtedly influence all quarters of Japan, including the bureaucracy, inciting them to distance the nuclear village whose persistence is still daily felt. The position of the Japanese Government will naturally be affected by all this, arrival of a new age.

I will continue to do my best to convince decision makers.

The world is not fully aware of the worsening crisis of Fukushima, symbolized by the Unit 4 and the contamination of the ocean. The world could be enlightened by the new movement of your Foundation.

Dear Mr. Fucetola,

I am sending you my message addressed to Prime Minister Abe. In it, I informed him of the following 4 new international moves aiming at preventing the consequences of Fukushima damaging the whole world.

Text of Message to Prime Minister

1. 17 renowned scientists has sent an appeal to Secretary-General Ban Ki-moon to establish an independent expert and citizen oversight boards, as well as removing Tokyo Electric Power Company (TEPCO) from the job of stabilizing the deteriorating situation at the ruined Fukushima Daiichi nuclear power station in Japan.

2. A Japanese lady, living in Los Angeles has started collecting 100 millions signatures for the petition asking President Obama to provide information not coming from the Japanese Government, nor from Tepco, but from an American institution and the international team to be established in Japan.

3. "Natural Solutions Foundation" has started a movement to create a NGO watchdog not dependent on Governments nor on international organizations. (cf. attached document)

4. Dr. Scott Jones, retired officer and former special adviser to Senator Claiborne Pell, compares Japan to Titanic, absorbed in preparing for the Olympic Games, refusing to accept international cooperation, when the unit 4 is heading toward collapsing. He foresees that nature will not allow the holding of the Olympic Games in 2020. (cf. attached document)

I am now warning that the fate of the world will be decided by electric companies.

Fukushima has proven justified my similar warning issued in 2004 concerning the fate of Japan. The existing crisis is conceived as that of the management of electric companies, not as the crisis of Japan as a nation. No wonder restarting and exporting occupy nuclear reactors constitute the central preoccupations of the concerned.

As the attached message shows, the world has started voicing its refusal to stay in the same boat with Japanese electric companies.

The restoration of the seriously blessed honor of Japan in the international society is urgently needed. The whole world is requiring the rectification of the stunning assertion that Fukushima is under control, made in order to influence the IOC decision in Argentina.

The will of heavens and the earth ,law of history, will not allow the present immoral situation to last long.

Urgent Appeal to Secretary-General Ban Ki-moon

I am extremely worried about the lack of the sense of crisis in Japan and abroad, as regards the worsening situation at the Fukushima Daiichi.

The international community is required to prevent the Fukushima accident from developing into the ultimate catastrophe of the world, a possibility the collapse of the Unit 4 by a mega earthquake could turn into a reality. It could happen at any moment !

Faced with this unprecedented crisis, the mobilization of human wisdom is required on the widest possible scale. The full assumption of responsibilities by the Japanese Government is urgently needed.

The present abnormal lack of the sense of crisis is due to the fact that inconvenient truth is not disclosed.

The international community has the duty, for example, to grasp correctly the precise volume of the continuous release of radiation from Fukushima.

In this connection, the official numbers published by Tepco, 10 million BQ/H, unchanged for the last year and half, could hardly be trusted. They remain unchanged even after the revelation by Tepco that, since the accident in 2011, 400 tons of contaminated water daily leaked into the sea. Now the Government admits that 300 tons daily flow into the sea. The situation is worsening. And no solution in sight!

The so called international strategy to consider that Fukushima accident did not happen, as some papers writes, is doomed to failure. This strategy is evidenced by the continued promotion of nuclear reactors worldwide, and their restarting and exporting by Japan..

Even if it succeeds to hide the head, it cannot hide the tail that is the contamination of the ocean on a planetary scale.

Conscientious citizens are now calling for the withdrawal of the invitation for Olympic games by Japan.
